

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

In this chapter, the researcher will deliver a message with a conclusion and suggestions based on the data. This conclusion explains how the amount of scenic has affected the outcome of “The Tomorrow War” movies. More detailed explanation follows.

5.1 Conclusions

The researcher discussed and analyzed deixis and its referents in The “The Tomorrow War” movie script. There are three kinds of deixis and six functions of deixis in the “The Tomorrow War” movie. There were 38 words indicated the person deixis, 8 words indicated the spatial deixis, and 9 words indicated the temporal deixis. Based on the result of this research, there were 36 utterances indicated the referential function, 6 utterances indicated the emotive function, 7 utterances indicated the conative function, 3 utterances indicated the metalingual function, 3 utterances indicated the phatic function, The researcher did not find the poetic function in this research. The researchers concluded that the most common kind of deixis found is person deixis, while the most common type of deixis function is referential. 5.2 Recommendations

The lecturers can use film or video to engage students in learning by using interesting media. Students can use this research as a reference to study pragmatics especially in the deixis field, and then apply it to their daily lives, such as social interactions.

The researcher recommends that they understand and acquire knowledge about the theory of deixis so that they may analyze deixis. By understanding the types of deixis which include person deixis, spatial deixis, and temporal deixis, also the functions of deixis which include referential, emotive, conative, metalingual, phatic, and poetic as well as the referent, readers are better able to comprehend text and to gain an understanding of its contents, environment, and what the speaker is trying to convey to the other researcher.
