CHAPTER III

METHOD OF THE RESEARCH

3.1. Research Design

This research starts from a phenomenon finding by researchers when they see many people reading literature, especially novel. The phenomenon is the understanding of the reader to interpreting or analyzing the symbols and images that appear in a literary work. From this phenomenon, the researcher feels the need to analyze the symbols and images that appear in a novel and finding the best theory to analyze the symbols and this picture is the theory of Carl Jung.

The most appropriate method employed in this research is the descriptive qualitative method. In the descriptive qualitative method is a way to collect all data in the form of words and images rather than numbers (Sugiono, 2012). This research discusses analyzing the symbols and images contained in Dracula novel by Bram Stoker using the theory of Carl Jung. Data collection methods used are documented with nothing technique. Content analysis methods are used to analyze data correctly. The research results are presented in a formal form where only the text is used to explain the results of the research.

3.2. Object of the Research

The object of research is very important to obtain scientific results. The researcher must be intelligent in using theory to analysis research. In this research, the researcher used the theory of Carl Jung archetypal image which is divided into eleven types. That is water, sun, color, circle, serpent, number, woman, wise old man, garden, tree, and dessert. The researchers focused on the use of

arctypalimages in Dracula Novel by Bram Stoker and analyzed the relationship or influence of the use of archatypal images found in the novel with the storyline and ending of Dracula novel by Bram Stoker.

3.3. Method of Collecting Data

This research is kind of library research which means that all the data that have been collect are in text, file and document form. Library research use documentation technique collecting data(Cresswell, 2014). Document is event that has been passed, could be written or creation monuments.

Theresearchers used to take note of techniques to understand the story of the Dracula novel. Researchers take notes all the important data to analyze all the data and to connect archetypal images according to Carl Jung. The novel is one kind of documentation cause, novel have been collected of the text. In collecting the data, the researcher took some steps to collect the data are as follows:

- Read the Dracula novel by Bram Stoker and try to understand better some topics in the story.
- Find some useful information and collect the data related to archetypal
 images from Dracula novel by Bram Stoker, such from another source like
 internet and other supporting source.
- 3. Go to libraries to find out books and information that can support this research analysis includes read the previous research and the novel.
- 4. Analysis the classification of data for type archetypal images found in the novel.

3.4. Method of Analyzing Data

In the analyzing the data, the researcher uses qualitative process analysis. It is to recognition, study, and understanding of interrelationship and concept in the data that hypotheses and assertions are developed and evaluated. In analyzing archetypal image based on the archetypal Approach by Carl Jung theory. In this the research, the researcher analyzes archetypal image of the novel.

- The researcher analyzes the archetypal image relationship related to the novel Dracula by Bram Stoker.
- 2. The researcher applies the Carl Jung Archetypal image theory with the image that found in Dracula novel by Carl Jung.
- 3. The final step will be making conclusion and finding research.

3.5 Method of Presenting Data

Method of presentation data has two kinds it is are formal and informal persentasion method. Formal persentasion is the researcher present the data analysis result by using simbol, signs,table and diagram. While informal presentasion method is the researcher present analysis data using words without

symbol, table, diagram or signs.
