

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

In this research, descriptive qualitative method is used as method to find out types and functions of conversational implicature in Dr. Phil's talk-show. Afterwards, researcher used implicature theory by Grice (1975) and supported by Brown & Levinson (1978) politeness strategies in analyzing the utterance. The researcher concluded from the result analysis and findings in the previous chapter that there were 30 data found which consisted of conversational implicature types and functions found in Dr. Phil's talk-show. As the result, first, most of the data categorized as particularized conversational implicature because of the talk show strongly-context bound or need special context in analyzing the implicit utterance. Second, researcher found four strategy of politeness used as the functions of conversational implicature, those are: positive politeness, negative politeness, off-record, and bald-on record. As the result, most of the data which categorized as particularized conversational implicature and used off-record strategy (indirect language).

From the explanation above, it can be concluded that conversational implicature is used to convey a message indirectly or with implicit way. The implicit meaning from speaker needed interpretation from hearer to get the message or idea based on the situation or the context of the conversation. Because of that, both

speaker and hearer need to understand the situation and background knowledge to get cooperative interaction.

5.2 Suggestion

Researcher realized there are some deficiency in this research. Because of that, researcher suggests the reader to understand the context of a conversation first before interprets the interlocutor utterance in order to reduce misunderstanding. Moreover, researcher suggests the reader who interested in discussing conversational implicature to do further research regarding to this study. Afterwards, researcher hopes this research gives benefits and knowledge to the reader. Therefore, researcher expects this research about conversational implicature can be useful for the future researchers who interest in this study or analyzed another similar topic of the function.
