

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

So the conclusion from this thesis is about persona which the researcher has concluded. Persona is the social role and character that can be played by an actor or actress. The role is where they show the original nature of the character to the public. Persona can also be interpreted as documentation whose contents explain the characteristics of the player which will be combined with getting a perfect goal in the character.

The researcher method used is descriptive qualitative method with data analysis research methods categorization. In addition, the researcher also uses several methods in collecting the data contained in this thesis such as: reading the novel, highlighting the data (collecting the data), writing the data again as data to be retrieved, and finally sorting or selecting the data to be entered into categorization. After collecting the data, the researcher uses some techniques in analyzing data, namely by inputting the data, reviewing the data again whether it has entered into categorization, sorting back the data, then analyzing the data that has been taken.

In this thesis there are 17 personas and 2 shadows that discuss the character of the main character. The results of this thesis can show the differences in the achievement of persona and shadow by presenting the character of Suzanna Collin in the analysis of archetype images.

In The Hunger Games players can run well with the character they use. The characters they get are in accordance with their respective characters in the real world. In which, the character of Katniss played by Jennifer Lawrence has a very brave nature and has excellent archery skills. In The Hunger Games, Katniss replaces her sister Primrose knowing that her sister is not capable of killing, so it is very likely that Primrose will die in the game. In addition, Katniss Everdeen is stubborn, which is where Peeta tries to protect her and make her the main symbol in the game. So that Peeta and her get more sponsors. But Katniss refuses and denies Peeta's action. Katniss considers what Peeta did is an act that is not very good in her opinion and considers Katniss a weak girl in front of the audience because she has received help from others just to get more sponsors for her.

Behind that too, Katniss cares and loves everyone around her. This is shown when Peeta is injured during the last games. It was Cato who tried to kill Peeta because he could not kill Katniss. His goal is to get Katniss to come to him because he gets word that Peeta is dead. However, with Peeta's painting skills, she manages to escape from Cato because he is likening himself to the rocks on the river bank. Katniss is overjoyed and takes Peeta into a cave where they are hiding. Peeta's condition is very worrying, almost on the edge of death. Katniss sees Peeta very sorry and tries to find a cure out. When it was announced that there would be food and need supplies provided by the capitol, Katniss insisted on going out and getting the supplies. She did not care what happened when she picked it up at the Cornucopia. And as a result she succeeded even though there was only a slight scratch on the side of her eye.

Shadow is a mask that is used by everyone to cover up his / her true nature in public. According to Carl Jung, shadow is an awareness that is below the conscious mind which can not be controlled by the ego which has the nature of something negative that is contained in humans. In fact, the ego is usually not too aware that it has a shadow. In addition, shadow is also referred to as dark side of humans which comes from natural instinctive, and instinctive archetypes that dwell within humans in a long process of transformation.

In this thesis there are 2 shadow that the researcher can conclude.
