

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the author tries to draw some conclusions from all the analyzes in Chapter IV. After concluding, the author also provides suggestions for further researchers who are interested in studying literature, especially novels.

5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing this thesis, the researcher comes to the final part which consists of conclusions. This conclusion is drawn based on the research problem and the results of the researcher's analysis. In this study, the researcher found two different social classes contained in the Crazy Rich Asian novel, the first is the upper social class and the middle social class. Crazy Rich Asian talks about the lives of Overseas and Mainland Chinese, who have different social classes and have an impact on their lives. The impact of social class inequality is social conflict that can occur in the family or society in the environment. In this Crazy Rich Asian novel, there are many social conflicts that become differences and disputes between families and between social classes.

The main conflict in this novel is raised because of differences of social class. The upper class rejects the presence of other classes in their environment. one of the reasons was because they thought that the other classes under them just wanted to take advantage of the situation to extort and

spend all the money and treasures of the upper class, as we can see from the situations that happened with Rachel and Nick's Family. But in fact, Rachel never wanted Nick's treasure. Even when she was dating Nick, Rachel never knew that Nick came from a wealthy family in Singapore. It proves that what the upper class thinks about the negative characteristic of the Middle and lower class is not true.

Another conflict in this novel is one of the real conflicts that occur in the lives of Asian people. One of the most familiar to hear and related to the story in this novel is when in choosing a partner for marriage, ethnic Chinese tend to choose a partner who comes from ethnic Chinese as well. This phenomenon actually happens in real life. So, the conclusion in this research is study about the differences in social class, the social stratification and the factors that raised it and their struggles.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the conclusions from the research above, after the researcher has completed this research, the researcher would like to convey some suggestions to the readers or further researchers. First, the researcher hopes that the reader will know the basics of a literary work, be it short stories or novels. Readers also gain an understanding of sociological theory and can relate literature to sociology. In addition, readers can also have an understanding of how to apply sociological theory in studying research related to social phenomena regarding social class such as the problem of

social stratification and class struggle in Kevin Kwan's Crazy Rich Asian novel by using Marx Weber's theories. and Karl Marx. Finally, for students at Putera Batam University, this thesis can be used as a reference in the preparation of a thesis on sociological literature by Marx Weber and Karl Marx.

5.2.1 Literature Students

The researcher expects that the analysis of the researcher can be useful for guiding the literature students in understanding sociological approach especially if the reader wants to conducted similar research. Indeed, there are many things that are very interesting to be analyzed more like the issues of social stratification faced by the middle class.

If the next researcher wants to do further research with a different approach, there are other interesting things that might be a reference in analyzing the Crazy Rich Asians novel besides analyzing the sociological approach. Morals obtained in the life of each character in the novel because this novel defines a lot of moral messages that we can take and relate to our life.
