CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

After analyzed the Fatherhood movie based on a linguistic perspective that focuses on the use of presupposition in the movie, the researcher concluded that in the Fatherhood movie had all the types of presupposition based on Yule's theory are found. Existential presupposition is the most common type with a total of 12 data from 41 data found. The second most common type of presupposition found is structural presupposition with a total of 9 data from 41 data found. The third most common type of presupposition is lexical presupposition with total of 7 data from 41. The next one is factive with a total of 6 data from 41 data found. The fifth most common type of presupposition is counter-factual presupposition with a total of 5 data from 41 data found. The last type of presupposition with the least amount of total data is a non-factive presupposition. Type of non-factive presupposition found only 2 data from a total of 36 data found. The existential presupposition is the most widely used type in this movie, meanwhile non-factive presupposition is the least used types in Fatherhood movie.

On the other hand, the implied meaning in this conversation is obtained by analyzing the context because in pragmatic studies, context is very important to know the implied meaning. The context of the conversation between the characters in the fatherhood movie is obtained from 4 factors. The first is the participant, the second is the setting or social context, the third is the topic of conversation and the last is the function of the conversation. Thus, this research found 41 data analyzed implied meaning. To find out the implied meaning of the utterances based on context, the researcher looked for the four elements of the context. There is the participant, the setting, the topic, and the function

In conclusion, that participants in conversations receive the presupposed information that the speaker utters. The context of utterance can be used to analyze the meaning of presupposition. Presupposition can be used to reveal information contained in a speaker's utterance. Moreover, the researcher can convey that information to the readers.

5.2 Suggestion

Following the completion of the research, the researcher advises those who will benefit from future research, particularly pragmatics. More research on the term presuppositions for communication in society, particularly in the English community. This is because English is widely used around the world and has evolved into an international language, necessitating an understanding of the language. In addition, the researcher anticipates that other researchers will use different research objects to avoid plagiarism.

This study's findings could be one of the references. It is recommended that those who study language or have linguistics as a concentration understand and study more about pragmatics, particularly presupposition, since presupposition deals with implied meaning that is not as easily understood as literal meaning.
