

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

5.1 Conclusion

In this study, the conversational implicature was discovered in the movie "A Quiet Place," which was said by the characters. The researcher discovered 35 pieces of information which related in conversational implicature. The researcher then determined two types and five functions based on Grice (1975) and Searle (2014). In this research the researchers have found 2 types of conversational implicature of 2 types which are indeed divided according to Grice.

As mentioned in the fourth chapter, namely the type of particularized conversational implicature, there are 34 data out of 35 data in the movie "A Quiet Place". One data out of 35 data of generalized conversational implicature type found in the movie "A Quiet Place". These types have been found with accurate research structures such as using comparable methods in analyzing and non-participatory observational methods in collecting the data.

There were 5 functions that have been discovered from the "A Quiet Place" movie in this research. These five functions have their respective place or function according to the context stated in this movie "A Quiet Place". The five functions are described as follows; 1 data out of 35 data for the declarative function, 9 data out of 35 data for the expressive function, 3 data

out of 35 data for the commissive function, 8 data out of 35 data for the directive function and 14 data out of 35 data for the assertive function where this function most of type function found the most in the movie "A Quiet Place".

The characters in the "A Quiet Place" movie preferred applied particularized conversational implicature as a type to utter the speakers' statements. It's such a real life, when people implicated or have some meaning in the sentence or dialogue by using conversational implicature and followed by the statements, conditions and reasons. It would raise the possibility of harmony in life and protect the speakers' faces and understanding. Then, the characters expressed all conversational implicature statements by their functions. It is the same with everyday life, if people want to do something, they should have to do it based on what its function is. By using the meaning that suits your needs, life will run smoothly.

5.2 Recommendations

To avoid face-saving behaviors and misunderstandings, as well as to foster collaboration between speakers and listeners, it is vital to understand and apply conversational implicature in social interactions. The study's goal is for readers to understand that implicature terms should be used as well as comprehended and for future researchers who may continue this research. Misunderstandings or misconceptions may be avoided when people are able

to communicate their implications in a respectful and accurate manner and comprehend the other person utilizing the implications correctly, without disturbing or frightening them in the face.

Then, for students concerned with their English studies, it is beneficial to obtain information in terms of pragmatics, particularly conversational implicature. Readers are expected to give the conversational implicature by studying it in order to promote peace and comprehend the speaker's aim in society.
