5.1 Conclusion

The types found in movies are generalized implicature and particularized implicature.

The second question of this research was the functions of conversational implicature. functions found in the movie are self-protection, power and politeness, to give information, to entertain the audience, and lack of specific information. This function they mostly use provides information, because in the movie the characters gave information, and sometimes the hearer's answers raise implicature. Therefore, the characters in the movie often have implied meanings.

Given that this study is about meaning, it demonstrated the significance of pragmatics in daily life. It is crucial to study pragmatics and gain more knowledge of acceptable and unacceptable meanings in conversation.
