### CHAPTER I

### INTRODUCTION

### 1.1 Background of The Study

Slang introduces the new word to enrich the language vocabularies with communicate the old word with the new meaning. The use of slang is like a mode. It is loved by many people who used, everywhere and thrown away quickly. Sometimes, slang is more attractive and expressive than standard language, the vocabulary not grammar or pronunciation and usually it is used by the high people not only the low people. Slang is considered as a result of the rapid growth of the new word or term that is happening. It is such kind of teenagers' creative expression to make the words simpler and efficient to be spoken. researchers, with various approaches and objects. One of the research is from Chetia in the year of 2015, which entitled "Slangs And Gender-A Sociolinguistic Perspective". The popular slangs in the Western world and India were analyzed and the causes were investigated. The commodification of women as seen from the usage of slangs in the Indian society was also analyzed. The study is based on responses to questionnaires and the data are analyzed using elementary statistics.

The differences between this research and Chetia's journal are the source data and the theory that used. This research use movie as the source data and analyzed the data from dialogue script while Chetia's using questionnaires to response and the data are analyzed using elementary statistics.

From the definition above, the researcher used a movie as the source data to analyze the using of slang language, in the movie one is able to learn many aspects of knowledge related to English language, especially everyday English. The example above is taken from the dialogue in *The Edge of Seventeen* movie. The setting is in a quite classroom at Lakewood Senior High School. This word is used by Nadine, the desperate girl. She uses this word when she talked to her teacher, Mr. Burner, about how desperate she is because she accidently sent an embarrassing message to her dream guy in school. As seen in the example the word *wanna* is slang word and it has the meaning *want to*. This word is called multiple process.
