CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

A conversation can be delivered well when the speaker and the hearer are trying to be cooperative. This research goes from the phenomenon that the researcher found related to cooperative principle called flouting maxim that appear in Tomorrowland movie. The using of flouting maxim types refers to a theory that proposed by Grice that already explained in the second chapter of this research. The using of flouting maxim types proved by the collecting of data related to the types of flouting maxim.

Based on the research analysis and findings which is about flouting maxim in Tomorrowland movie, there are two main conclusions that can be drawn. First, from 4 types of flouting maxim which introduced by Grice, the type of flouting maxim of relation is the most often appear in Tomorrowland movie (by asking about the pin). It happens because both the speaker and the hearer in the movie often have different interpretation and understanding of the context of situation. Second, the most of the speaker flout the maxim with the intention to show feeling (dislike). It happens because many characters in the movie tend to give up easily. Finally, the main point is the relationship among the characters influence the intention of the speaker in flouting of the maxim.

5.2 Suggestions

In making completing the analysis of this thesis, the researcher presents some suggestions to the language user and the next researcher. The suggestions are written as follows:

- The language user is suggested to obey the maxim (cooperative principle) in other words, people should follow the rules in conversation to avoid violation and misunderstanding.
- 2. To the next researcher who wants to conduct cooperative principle, especially in flouting maxims, the next researcher is expected to read more about theory of Grice cooperative principle, so the comprehension of it can be gain fully.
