

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the researcher presents the conclusion from the findings in the previous research and also give a suggestion for further studies on the same issues about neo-Gricean pragmatic theory by Laurence R Horn.

5.1. Conclusion

After analyzing all the data in the previous chapter, the researcher writes the conclusion of the result to answer the first and the second formulation from chapter one. The answer for the first formulation in chapter one, the researcher watches the film Sherlock season 3 and collect randomly for 25 utterances for the data. After that the researcher analyzes all the 25 data and find out that the most dominant types of Horn's principle are the Q-principle which demands the speaker to say as much as you can. For more specific, there are 18 utterance data that is a part of the Q-principle and the rest of the 7 data is a part of R-principle.

The answer for the second formulation in chapter one, the researcher analyzes the utterance that used Horn's principle using the speech act theory to find out the function of every utterances that used Horn's principle. After analyzing all of the 25 data, the most dominant function is representative and to be more specific, there are 16 data that have the representative function, 4 data is included in expressive function, another 4 data is included in directives function, only 1 data is included

in commissive functions. The researcher does not find any data that included in declaratives function.

5.2. Suggestion

This research has reached its conclusion. However, it is still far from being perfect, and therefore, the researcher demands for further research. The researcher hopes that the finding of this research could help other researcher for the further research. The researcher will also give a further suggestion for other researchers as stated below:

1. Further study should widen the search of the theory of neo-Gricean pragmatic by Laurence R Horn to understand more about theory.
2. The other researchers also need to try the other neo-Gricean pragmatic theory that was conduct by Levinson.
3. The other researchers need to understand the cooperative principle theory which is about the maxim of conversation, before conduct a research using neo-Gricean theory.
