CONCLUSION

5.1. Conclusion

In this part, this research goes from a son who wants to keep his family together and makes his family happy in "The Glass Menagerie" drama. In this research, the researcher analyzed the ways main character satisfies his love and belonging needs and obstacles of the main characters in pursuing his love and belonging needs

The theory described in the previous chapter is using the theory of Abraham H. Maslow or also better known as the Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs. Then, the data were collected by reading the contents of the script drama and analyzed.

The data are analyzed in depth and summarized as found in satisfying Tom's love and belonging needs toward family and the obstacles of Tom in pursuing his love and belonging needs. In satisfying his love and belonging needs toward family, he tried to lower his selfishness and listened and do to what his mother and his sister asked to him. In contrast, the obstacles of the main character, Tom faced that his father has left him and his family, his mother obsession about the gentleman caller, and he and his mother always quarrel.

In satisfying love and belonging needs toward family, sometimes human will face the obstacles, but if they can cooperate in building the intact and happy family, lower the ego, and listen to each other of family member. From research
