CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 CONCLUSION

This study aims to find out the decision-making proces to preserve marriage after her does a love affair. based on research that has been done, then in this section will be further explained the conclusions, and recommendations that can be used to develop subsequent studies.

From the description in the previous chapter, it can be concluded that:

- 1. Love affair committed by wife is a painful thing for themselves. They also said that the affair happened because factors contained in the subject such as lack of attention or not meet the expectations of the husband.
