

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the researcher presents the conclusion and suggestion. The analysis in the previous chapters are concluded and finally the researcher will attempt to suggest some important matter concerning to the discussion of this thesis. The suggestion are considered to be important for everyone especially reader or other researcher who is going to conduct the research in the same field.

5.1. Conclusion

Based on the analysis of research finding in chapter IV researcher make the conclusion as follows:

1. From the analysis in chapter IV, the researcher found 3 words or phrase or sentence contain figurative language. From ten types of figurative languages that want to be analyzed, the researcher only found nine types; simile, metaphor, hyperbole, personification, irony, paradox, metonymy, allegory and symbol. The researcher cannot find the type of synecdoche.
2. Based on the result analysis, the researcher calculates the total data for each item to find composition scale of figurative languages from the novel. After finding the composition scale, the researcher found the highest percentage is hyperbole with 23.80% that can be seen in table 4.1 Chapter IV.

5.2. Suggestion

Based on research that has been done, it is known that in the novel, there are many sentences that used figurative language. In this study, the researcher is limited by theory that the researcher used to analyze the novel so there is only a few types of figurative language that can be discussed in this thesis. From the explanation above, the researcher can suggest for future research that researchers can use different theories with the same data so that all types of figurative meanings found in the novel can be discussed totally.

Researchers can also conduct research on different data with different theories so that readers know the difference of the roles of figurative language in a literary work such as a novel, to the figurative language used in advertisements, songs, etc. So, the readers can understand the figurative language, the types of figurative language and understand the function and the roles in a literary work well. Furthermore the readers will no longer have difficulty to interpret the meaning of the sentences that used figurative language.
