

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This case is the final chapter of this research, the writer divided into conclusion and suggestion. This case includes all conclusion from the result of the data has been analyze in chapter five and the writer gives advices in suggestion part.

5.1 CONCLUSION

After analyzing the use of deixis from chapter one until chapter fifteen Matthew's book in Holy Bible, the writer conclude that:

1. Deixis concerns with the ways in which language encode or grammatically features of the context of utterance or speech event and thus also concerns ways in which interpretation of utterances depend on the analysis of the context of utterance”.
2. There are three types of deixis that the writer analyzed found in fifteen chapters of Matthew's book in Holy Bible, they are: person deixis (1130 occurrences), social deixis (456 occurrences), and discourse deixis (288 occurrences).
3. After analyze three types of deixis, the most dominant type of deixis which occurs in the fifteen chapters of Matthew's book in Holy Bible is person deixis with 1130 occurrences from the totally all deixis found (1874 occurrences).

4. “*He*”, is dominantly use in the fifteen chapters of Matthew’s book, Holy Bible, among another kinds of person deixis.

5.2 SUGGESTION

Based on the result the research, the writer would like to give some suggestion. The following suggestions are offered:

1. It is expected to readers, especially for the students of English department to deepen their knowledge more about deixis, because by knowing deixis, it will help the students to catch the target meaning of a certain text or a discourse easier.
2. It is suggested to the other writers to do the further research on deixis in another field and another object to enrich the readers’ understanding about deixis.
