## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestion based on finding and discussion of the data analysis.

## 5.1 Conclusion

Throughout the novel, the main character faces many issues regarding her love and belonging needs, which she struggles to overcome. An example of her struggle is that she has to work, this means a social life is very difficult for her to have and this is one of the reasons for her social issues.
