

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

5.1 Conclusion

The result of the research is analyzed and formulated by utilizing the theory of types of illocutionary acts by Searle and Vanderveken (1985) and the theory of the functions of illocutionary acts by Leech (1983). In total, there are 40 data found and analyzed in this research which consists of 6 data of refuse, 3 data of promise, 6 data of offer, 1 data of vow, 5 data of threat, 4 data of commit, 6 data of accept, 8 data of guarantee, and 1 data of bet. With the same data then are categorized using the theory of functions which resulted in 7 data of competitive, 13 data of conflictive, 14 data of convivial, and 6 data of collaborative. All of the data are collected and categorized from the “Tangled” Movie.

From the mentioned data, it can be concluded that the most common type found in the “Tangled” Movie is guarantee as the movie is a children movie, there are a light fantasy theme that carry a positive atmosphere. Therefore, throughout the movie the lead character can be seen supporting each other in the journey with affirmation. On the other hand, the type of pledge is not found in “Tangled” Movie. Pledge is commonly used in a formal and serious situation where the speaker shows their commitment to the listener. During Rapunzel and Flynn’s visit to the kingdom, no formal scene that requires serious dedication found. As for the function, convivial is the most commonly found function in “Tangled” Movie. As the movie is directed as children as the main audience, the lead characters’ utterances are conveyed with a lot of position intention and purpose

throughout the movie. The least common function found is collaborative as the movie is filled with positive atmosphere and since the characters are always conversing with one and another, there are almost always a social goal involve. Hence, it can be simplified that “Tangled” Movie shows characters who converse with each other positively along with assures and support of one and another with a positive intention for each other’s good and well-being.

5.2 Recommendation

The researcher hopes that this research will be at use for future reference for other researcher to analyze regarding type and function of illocutionary act. This research can also be applied in daily life or other literary work to understand action conveyed by word rather than action. The researcher also has recommendation for future researcher who is interested with the topic. First, the researcher recommends that the future researcher can explore other type and function of illocutionary acts as this research focuses on commissive acts. Second, the research recommends that future researcher explore different variation of illocutionary acts such as factor and construction of the utterance. Last, the research recommends that the future research use different literary work as the object such as novel, or short story. Real life conversation can also be used as an object such as TV shows or documentary.
