CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

3. 1. Research Design

Descriptive qualitative is a technique that combines textual data, descriptive data, and interaction variables in this study. Descriptive qualitative differs from descriptive quantitative in general in data collection, analysis, interpretation, and report writing. (Creswell, 2014) states that descriptive qualitative is informed by purposeful sampling, open data collection, analysis of text or images, representation of information in figures and tables, and personal interpretation of findings. This chapter describes the process of implementing qualitative procedures into a research proposal and contains checklists to ensure that researcher covered up all required procedures. The analysis of this research presented in a qualitative descriptive method because data of the research are in the form of sentence or utterance that taken from the data source that not in form number.

3. 2. Object of the Research
