CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Chapter V provides the conclusion and recommendations. The conclusion made and got from the analysis of chapter IV which is the hero stages that experienced by Quentin, the main character and the difficulties faced by Quentin while did the stages. The recommendations are stated as the insights for students or other researchers.

5.1 Conclusion

After all the analysis from Quentin character and his hero journey from chapter IV, then it could be concluded that Quentin goes through almost all the hero stages. But he didn't go stage of the magic flight only. Even tough Quentin refuses Margo invitation, but Quentin chose to go with her and did as Margo's plan. In the separation stage, the researcher found 9 datas as follow: The call to adventure (2), refusal of the call (3), supernatural aid (1), the crossing of the first threshold (1), and the belly of the whale (2). For the next stage, is transformation. The transformation finding datas as follow: The road of the trial (2), the meeting with the goddess (1), woman as the temptress (2), atonement with the father (2), apotheosis (2), the ultimate boon (2). In the return stage, the researcher found 8 datas as follow: Refusal of the return (3), rescue from without (2), the crossing of the return threshold (1), master of two worlds (1), and freedom to live (1). Researcher found 3 difficulties there are Insecurity, doubtness, and fear.

5.2 Recommendations

This is the end of this paper. After all the explanation and analysis, there are some recommendations that researcher would like to give to other researcher or future researcher and students particularly students of English Literature. First recommendations are this novel could be analyzed using other theories for instance psychoanalysis/psychology.
