CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter contains conclusion and suggestion regarding to the analysis of the research and findings from the previous chapters. The conclusion of this research consists of the research's summary, which are the types of language style and functions of language found in "Avatar: The Way of Water" Movie. Meanwhile, the suggestion is filled with the recommendation of research for readers regarding the research about language style.

5.1 Conclusions

The analysis and findings of language style on "Avatar: The Way of Water" Movie that applied the theory of language style by Joos (1976), had resulted and found that all five of the language style existed in the movie with total data of 28 utterances. To name it all in detail, the most formal style which is frozen style has 2 data, continue with formal style has 4 data, then consultative style has 6 data, next casual style has 6 data, and the most informal style which is intimate style has 10 data. To conclude the analysis of language style in this study, the most formal style which is frozen style, found to be infrequently applied by the characters in the movie as the movie focused more on the casual relationship between characters. In the other hand, intimate style as the most informal style is applied by the characters the most in the movie, because casual and informal conversations between characters are frequently performed in the movie, and it focused in showing the situations of casual life of the characters. Meanwhile, the analysis of language functions by using the theory of Leech (1981) had resulted on the findings of all five language functions as theorized with total 11 data. The detail of five language functions found in this research are informational function with 2 data, expressive function with 3 data, directive function with 3 data, aesthetic function with 2 data, and phatic function with 1 data. The findings can be concluded that the phatic function is infrequently applied by the characters in the movie because the characters rarely had conversations that contain words of keeping a good relationship. While, expressive and directive functions are found to be frequently applied by the

characters in the movie of "Avatar: The Way of Water". Expressive function is applied by the characters the most because they often express their own feelings and ideas, in the other hand, directive function is also found to be applied the most because the movie contained some war situations that led to the use of directive

5.2 Suggestions

The researcher hopes that this research can be useful as references for other researchers, teachers, lecturers, and students to understand more about language style. The researcher expects that this research can be useful in order to understand more in using either formal or informal style in different situations of society. However, the researcher is conscious of the lacks in this research, as there are other research topics and experts' theories that the researcher is unable to bring, therefore the researcher would like suggest some topics for future researchers in order to further the research on language style. First of all, the researcher suggests the future researcher to conduct the analysis of language style by using other theories than the theory used in this research, such as the theory of language functions by Jakobson. Then, the researcher suggests to conduct a research of language style on data source other than the movie in this research, which can be from novels, movies, short videos, or so on.
