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ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini menganalisis tema feminism dalam novel *The Awakening* karya Kate Chopin melalui teori feminism eksistensial Simone de Beauvoir, dengan fokus utama pada citra perempuan dan perlakuan tidak adil yang dialami oleh tokoh utama dalam perjuangannya untuk mencapai kemandirian, keberanian, dan pemberontakan di tengah struktur patriarki yang membatasi kehidupannya. Pendekatan deskriptif kualitatif digunakan untuk mengidentifikasi dan menganalisis unsur intrinsik novel, seperti alur, karakter, latar, dan tema yang mencerminkan ketidakadilan sosial terhadap perempuan. Desain penelitian ini mengikuti metode Creswell (2015) dan Vanderstoep & Johnston (2009), dengan data yang dikumpulkan melalui metode penelitian kepustakaan sesuai dengan panduan dari Ratna (2015). Analisis data dilakukan secara deskriptif untuk memberikan pemahaman yang mendalam dan sistematis tentang masalah yang diangkat dalam novel. Penelitian ini menemukan empat kategori citra perempuan, yaitu mandiri, pemberontak, berani, dan peduli, masing-masing didukung oleh empat data, serta dua kategori perlakuan tidak adil, yakni dari keluarga (5 data) dan masyarakat (4 data). Temuan penelitian menunjukkan bahwa citra perempuan dalam novel ini mencerminkan perjuangan melawan konsep *immanence* menurut Beauvoir, di mana perempuan dibatasi pada peran-peran tertentu yang mengakibatkan penindasan. Penelitian ini juga mengungkapkan perlakuan tidak adil dari keluarga dan masyarakat yang menghambat perempuan untuk mencapai kemandirian, serta memberikan kritik tajam terhadap sistem patriarki yang menghalangi perkembangan dan kebebasan perempuan.

ABSTRACT

This research analyzes feminist themes in Kate Chopin's *The Awakening* through Simone de Beauvoir's existential feminist theory. The primary focus of the study is on the image of women in the novel and the unfair treatments faced by the character in the struggle to achieve autonomy, courage, and rebellion within a patriarchal structure that restricts her. A qualitative descriptive approach is applied to identify and analyze intrinsic elements of the novel, including plot, characters, settings, and themes that reflect social injustices toward women. Additionally, this research uses a qualitative descriptive design as outlined by Creswell (2015) and Vanderstoep & Johnston (2009), with data collected through library research methods as per Ratna (2015). Data analysis follows a descriptive approach, providing a deep understanding of intrinsic elements of the novel. Results are presented descriptively to ensure clarity and insight into the injustices faced by women within patriarchal societies. Four categories of image of woman are found in the novel "The Awakening" by Kate Chopin: independent, rebellious, brave, caring with 4 data each. And two categories of unfair treatment found in the novel "The Awakening" by Kate Chopin: family with 5 data and society with 4 data. The findings reveal that character image of women represents women's struggles against Beauvoir's concept of immanence, where women are confined to limited roles and experience oppression. The study also highlights the unfair treatment from family and also from society of women's inability to achieve autonomy, as well as critiques of patriarchal systems that hinder women's personal development and freedom.
