

## **CHAPTER III**

### **METHODOLOGY OF THE RESEARCH**

#### **3.1 Research Design**

Litosesseliti (2010) claims, qualitative research focuses on how something is, its structure, and its patterns. Researchers choose to employ qualitative research since the study's findings are expressed in words or phrases due to the method of analysis, data collection, and analysis results. This study provided a descriptive explanation.

Establishing a systematic and accurate representation of the data is the main goal of using this descriptive approach. Because it offers information on how slang is used in daily life, and since these slang terms are derived from words, the information is descriptive.

#### **3.2 Object of Research**

The key to a study is the research object. Slang terms are the subject of this study. The types of slang terms and their purposes in the lyrics of a few chosen songs by the New Hope Club Band are the subjects of this study. While the researcher used the theory from Mattiello (2008) to analyze and categorize the purposes of the slang terms, the researcher used the theory from Allan and Burridge's (2006) book to study the categories of slang words.

### **3.3 Methods of Data Collection**

To collect data, the researcher used the observational approach. The observational strategy was used to gather data through observation (Sudaryanto, 2015). Non-participatory data collection techniques were used because the researcher was not involved in the songwriting process. In order to collect data, the researchers took a number of actions. They first watched the film and took notes on the speeches that were used. They then noted every occurrence of slang used in the movie's speeches. Finally, they arranged the data in the appropriate categories. The observational strategy uses observation to collect data.
