CONCLUSION

After analyzing the use of slang among Gen Z in Batam, the researcher found that slang plays an essential role in shaping informal communication and social identity. Slang is more than just a set of trendy words; it reflects the way young people connect, express emotions, and establish group belonging. The rapid development of slang is influenced by various factors, including digital culture, social interactions, and the need for self-expression. Social media platforms, online gaming, and daily conversations contribute to the constant evolution of slang, making it an essential part of modern communication.

This study revealed that slang words are often formed through different linguistic processes, such as clipping, blending, and compounding. These processes allow words to become shorter, more creative, and easier to use in fast-paced conversations. The dynamic nature of slang shows how language continuously adapts to social and technological changes.

Furthermore, the researcher discovered that slang serves multiple functions, including praising, to address, and descriptive. These functions help individuals communicate their feelings more effectively and add emotional depth to conversations. Whether it is used to compliment someone, show disappointment, or express frustration, slang makes communication more relatable and engaging.

Overall, the findings of this study highlight the evolving nature of language and how younger generations contribute to linguistic innovation. Understanding slang provides insight into the cultural influences that shape modern communication. This study contributes to a deeper understanding of linguistic creativity and emphasizes the importance of studying slang as a reflection of societal trends and youth identity.

The data collected from social media in Batam revealed that Gen Z frequently uses slang in various ways. Among the slang terms analyzed, 24 data points were categorized as descriptive, meaning these words were used to describe situations, emotions, or people in a unique and informal way. Additionally, 9 data points fell under the "to address" category, indicating that these slang words were used to refer to or call someone in a specific manner, often in a casual or humorous tone. Lastly, 2 data points were categorized under praising, showing that Gen Z uses certain slang expressions to compliment or admire someone's actions, appearance, or achievements. This analysis highlights how slang in Batam's Gen Z community serves different functions in their daily digital conversations.

The data collected from social media in Batam showed that Gen Z uses different types of slang formation in their daily conversations. Among the slang terms identified, **9 data points** were categorized as **clipping**, where longer words were shortened while keeping their original meaning, making communication faster and more casual. Additionally, **1 data point** was classified as **compounding**, meaning two or more words were combined to create a new slang term with a unique meaning. Furthermore, **9 data points** fell under **blending**, where parts of two different words were merged to form a new slang word. This analysis highlights how Gen Z in Batam creatively modifies

language in social media interactions, reflecting their dynamic and evolving communication style.

5.2. Suggestion

Theoretically, this research is expected to contribute to future studies on slang language, especially in understanding how new words are created and used by Gen Z in Batam. Language is always changing, and slang plays a big role in shaping how people communicate. By studying slang, future researchers can gain a better understanding of how words are formed, why they become popular, and how they spread within a community. Additionally, slang is not just about words; it is also a reflection of social identity and cultural trends. Future research can explore different types of slang used by various groups and how these words represent the thoughts, emotions, and lifestyle of the people using them. It is also important to study how slang evolves over time and whether it becomes a permanent part of the language or fades away. A more detailed and broader analysis of slang formation and usage will help linguists and language researchers understand the deeper aspects of communication, especially among young people.

Practically, this research aims to help readers understand the importance of slang in daily conversations, especially among Gen Z in Batam. Slang is often used to express emotions, build social connections, and create a sense of belonging among peers. By studying slang, people can improve their ability to communicate effectively in informal settings and better understand the way young people interact with each other. This research also highlights the impact of slang on digital

communication, such as social media, where new words and phrases spread quickly. Understanding slang can help individuals, including parents, teachers, and language learners, adapt to modern communication trends. Additionally, this research is hoped to encourage further exploration of how slang influences language learning, personal identity, and even professional communication in the future.
