CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing the data in this undergraduate thesis, the researcher found in "Circe" novel, the researcher concluded that the phenomena the double construction in Ancient Greek happened to the female characters, especially Circe in Circe novel by Madeline Miller. Circe was getting the bad treatment from her own family especially her father that didn't believe she had power. Her father still believed on the patriarchal system where woman should be submissive, subordinate and indoctrinating stereotyping as he persuaded their daughters that males or god had to control their life because they didn't have as much power as gods did.

The first conclusion was Circe as the main character of this novel explained from her point of view that women tended to get discrimination as the patriarchal still hold power over woman's life. Circe especially as the main character of this novel had to be submissive, subordinate as the indoctrinating stereotyping of woman should agree in every situation. This situation forced her to do rebellion that caused her to get exiled from her home.

The second conclusion was, Circe along with her mother and other women often had to follow the rule that the patriarchal system made. When she discovered her ability as a witchcraft and could change every object with only her thought, her father felt threatened and she could cause harm to whole creatures.

The ability of witchcraft made her thought of woman indeed could hold power too. She realized after she got exiled, woman as a tough woman, inner power of woman and woman's ambition could break the double construction.

5.2 Suggestion

After concluding this thesis, the researcher realized that this thesis had imperfections. The researcher believed the suggestion were needed for the next student who would conduct this thesis using feminist approach.

- 1. The researcher hopes the next student who wants to use the Circe novel can inspect more and apply literary approaches that can this novel as an object of the research. Thereafter, the researcher hopes the student also can use the theory of Sherrie A. Inness from one of her books "New Images of Tough Women".
- 2. Hopefully this thesis could be used for the next student especially for student of English language and literature in Putera Batam University to analyze about the double construction, especially related to feared with its sub-chapter, new woman as a tough woman, inner power woman and woman's ambition along with its result of woman should be conquered and its sub-chapter, indoctrinating stereotyping, submissive, and subordinate as the result of women can break the patriarchal system and have the same equality. The fear of losing their power makes the patriarchal system construct the double construction. In the Circe novel, it shows that women also have the strength and power to break the patriarchal system as the stereotype of woman is a weak human being.
