CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the analysis described in Chapter IV, there are several forms of racism that affect the life of the main character in the novel. Starting from the name Nigger refers to the black slave in Mrs. Watson's house. Then there was a sale and purchased of slaves to the mastery of slaves by their master. Jim as the main character who got these acts of racism got support from another main character, Huck. Jim and Huck were two different humans according to social class in 19th century America. Jim was one of the black descents while Huck was of white ancestry. But here, Huck described to help Jim's struggle to get out of his torturous slavery. They both work together to get out of the city and seek their freedoms. Some of their struggles to get out of slavery were like running away from his master's house. Then Huck's support was lying to every citizen they met. Huck bragged a lot in order to save Jim and his fate. They also hide a lot so that they didn't find out.
