

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1. Conclusion

The utterances in this research just discussed utterances that made by the guests in the Spill Your Guts show. Most of the utterances contained directive speech act. The types of directive speech act which is command becomes a speech that commonly used by the guests in the show. Request and suggestion rarely used by the guests because in the talk show mostly command other people to eat a disgusting food. Meanwhile, the functions of speech act which is commanding also become a speech that commonly used by the guests in the show. The same reason for other functions of speech act are rarely used.

This research found that the reasons why the participant employ certain directive are analyzed based on the speaker's purposes in uttering the directive, whether for his own benefit or the hearer's benefit. The reasons of the directives performed by the characters in this show are classified into four, (1) the speaker wants to show his/her care about the hearer, (2) the speaker wants to warn the hearer, (3) the speaker wants to show his/her authority, (4) the speaker wants to direct/instruct the hearer.

5.2. Suggestion

The result of this study could give suggestion for the future researcher especially one who want to studies directive speech acts that the context of where the utterance takes place determined the type and reason of directive acts.

When it takes place in a talk show which the air is casual and full of humor, directive acts can be found in the implicit utterance. And also, the future researcher can compare the directive speech acts theory or combine the theory with other experts. It will be an interesting research because experts have different strategies of directive speech acts. From combining two or more theories of strategies by experts, the future researcher can be found more interesting directive acts utterance in different contexts of situation.
